After the concrete is cured and extracted from the form, the retarder is washed away, revealing an image that results from the contrast between the fair-faced (smooth) surface and the exposed aggregate surface. It is as durable and maintenance-free as concrete itself. ■ You can select various aggregates and pigments to dramatically expand possibilities in the finished surface. ■ Precast concrete has a new look.
