The <u>Armerding Center for Music and the Arts</u> was a two phase renovation project. While the first phase included the development of a state-of-the-art recital hall, sound-cancelling practice rooms and classrooms, two recording studios, and faculty studios, Mid-States was a proud project partner on the second phase. The second phase, completed in September 2020, included a 650-seat acoustically-engineering concert hall, a choral rehearsal room, and grand lobby.

"The product and the project was amazing," said Dean Michael Wilder. "I was really, really grateful for this approach and for the ways this made an amazingly efficient and well-constructed approach. It's really amazing."

Wilder said because the facility serves so many important purposes on campus, they focused on three main things: acoustics, function, and aesthetics - in that order.
